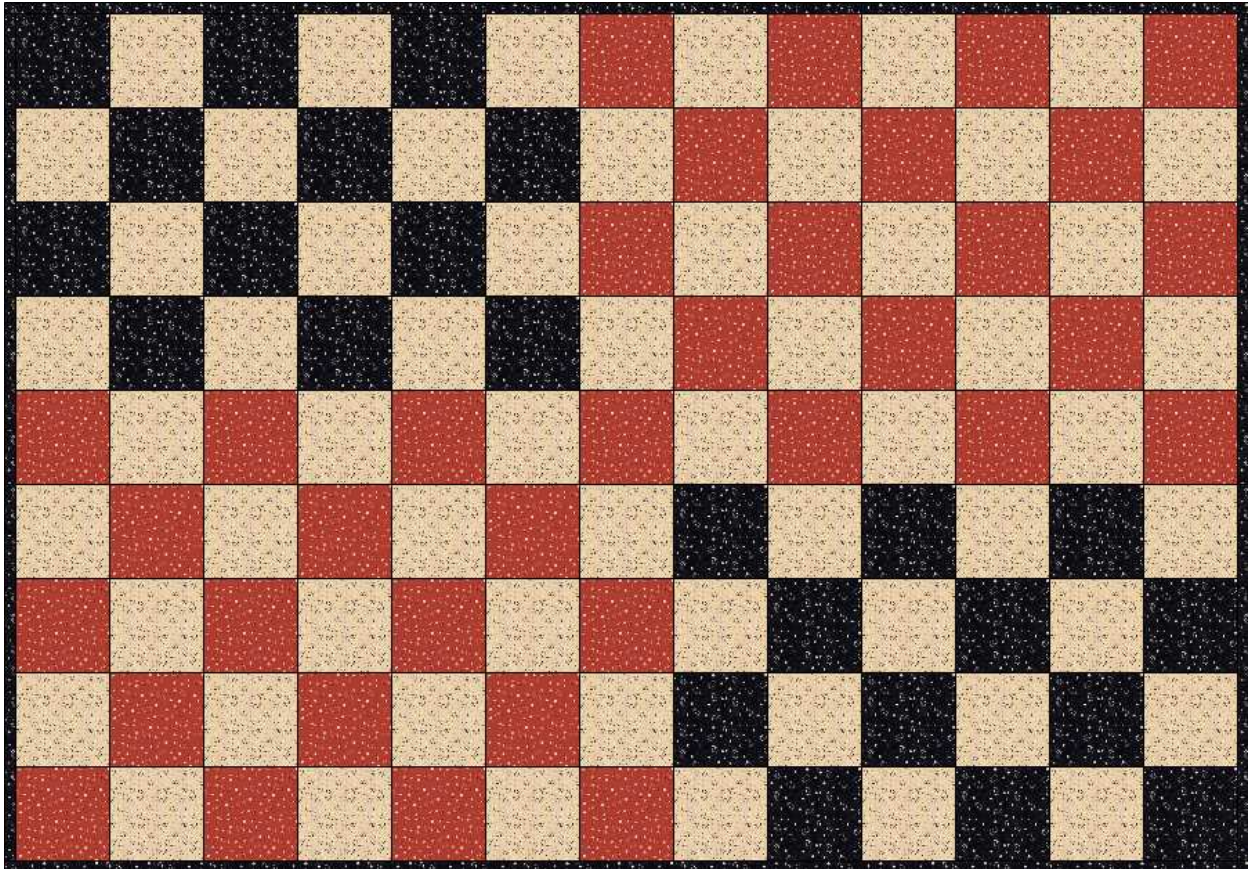

Fabric Requirements:

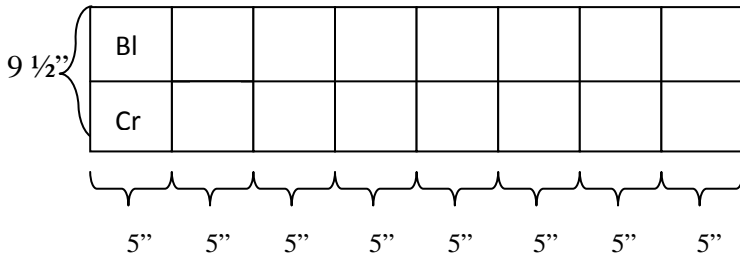
Red (Item #F423-111D)	3/4 Yard	Cut 5 – 5” Strips the Width of the Fabric
Cream (Item #F426-142D)	1 ¼ Yards	Cut 8 – 5” Strips the Width of the Fabric
Blue (Item #F423-110D)	½ Yard	Cut 3 – 5” Strips the Width of the Fabric
Binding Fabric (Your Choice):	½ Yard	Cut 6 Strips the Width of the Fabric for the Binding (Choose your Favorite Width up to 3”)
Backing Fabric (Your Choice):	2 2/3 Yards	Cut 2 – 1 1/3 Yard Pieces (Horizontal Seam)

Page Two

Blue Pairs:

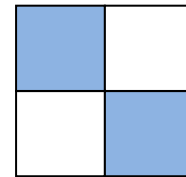
- Sew a blue strip to a cream strip along the length of the fabric. Press the seams toward the blue strip. Make a total of three strip sets. The width of these strip sets should be $9\frac{1}{2}$ ".



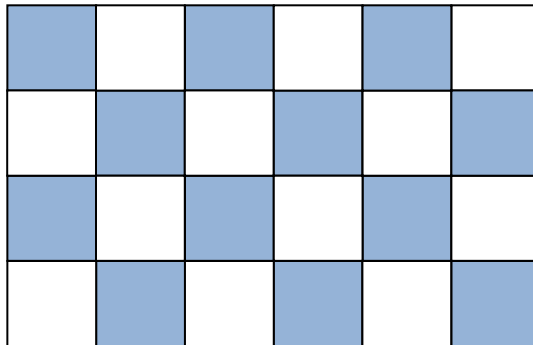
- Cut each strip set into 8 – 5" pairs. You need 24 pairs.

Blue Four-Patches – Make a total of 12:

- Sew two pairs with like colors diagonal from each other to form a four-patch.

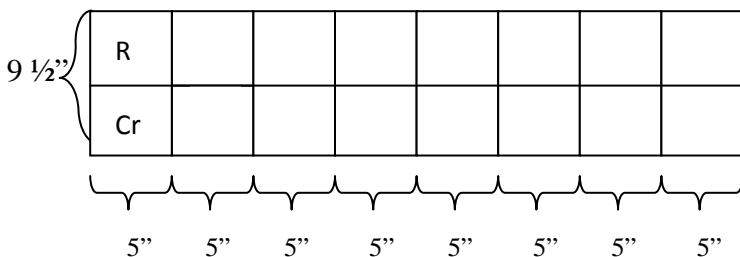


Sew six of these four patches together – butting seams - to form two rows of three four-patches. Make a total of two units.



Red Pairs:

- Sew a red strip to a cream strip along the length of the fabric. Press the seams toward the red strip. Make a total of five strip sets. The width of these strip sets should be $9\frac{1}{2}$ ". Cut each strip set into 8 – 5" segments. You need 35 pairs. 24 will be used for the four-patches.

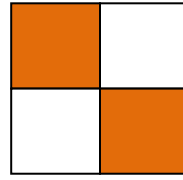

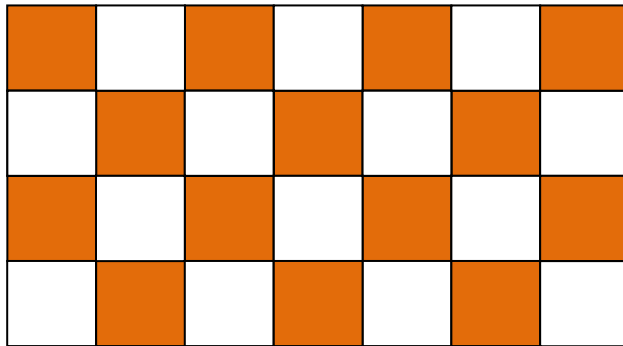
Page Three

Red Four-Patches – Make a total of 12:

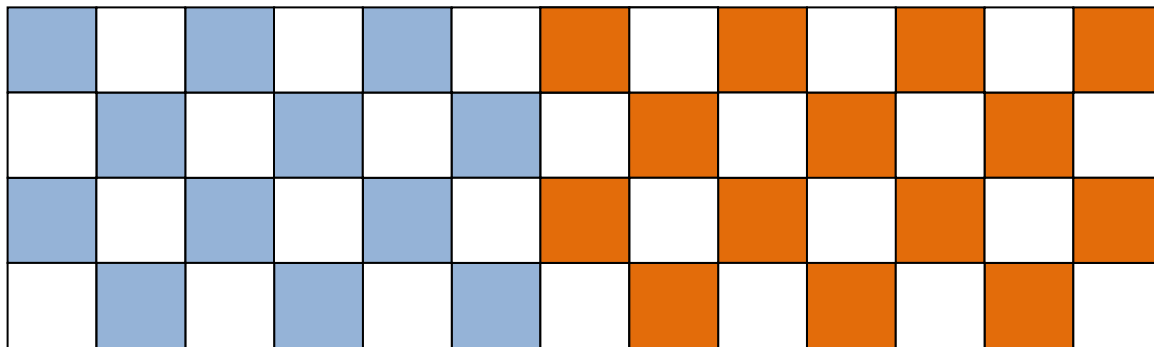
- Sew two pairs with like colors diagonal from each other to form a four-patch.



- Sew six of these four patches together – butting seams - to form two rows of three four-patches. Make a total of two units. Sew two of the remaining pairs together along the 2 1/2" side to form a row of four squares. Add this strip to the end of the pieced unit. Make a total of two units.



- Sew two of these pieced units together, butting seams. Press.



- Sew seven of the red pairs together to make a row of fourteen squares. Remove one white square from the end of the row so that you have thirteen squares – beginning and ending with a red square.



- Using the picture as a guide, sew these three sections together to complete the quilt top.
- Quilt and bind as desired.

Red Fabric (3/4 Yard):

Cut 5 – 5” Strips the Width of the Fabric

Any Way You Look At It

Cream (1 1/4 Yards):

Cut 8 – 5” Strips the Width of the Fabric

Any Way You Look At It

Blue (1/2 Yard):

Cut 3 – 5” Strips the Width of the Fabric

Backing Fabric (2 2/3 Yards):

Cut 2 – 1 1/3 Yard Pieces (Horizontal Seam)

Cut 6 Strips the Width of the Fabric for the Binding
(Choose your Favorite Width up to 3”)
