SUMMER MIX

Size 44" x 57" Block Size 12"

Requirements

White fabric 1.40m

One fat 1/8 of each of the following.

H80 col. 2 Multi- coloured flower with blue roses.

H80 col. 4 Multi- coloured flower with pink roses.

H80 col. 5 Tonal green flower.

H80 col. 6 Tonal pink flower.

H80 col. 7 Tonal blue flower.

H80 col. 8 Tonal yellow flower.

H81 col. 1 Blue roses on pink shadow ground.

H81 col. 2 Pink roses on blue shadow ground.

H81 col. 3 Pink roses on yellow shadow ground.

H83 col. 1 Small sprigs on pink ground.

H83 col. 2 Small sprigs on blue ground

H83 col. 3 Small sprigs on yellow ground

For the sashing

H82 col. 1 Pink floral stripe.

H82 col. 2 Blue floral stripe.

H82 col. 3 Yellow floral stripe

H85 col. 12 Pink and blue check.

H85 col. 32 Blue and yellow check.

H85 col. 41 Pink and green check.

Template plastic

Backing & Wadding - 48" x 61"

Cutting

Make the template, adding an extra $\frac{1}{4}$ " for seam allowance.

All seam allowances have been included in the cutting.

From the White fabric, cut

12 x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " squares, cut in half diagonally twice.

20 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

6 x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" strip, for outer border.

48 from the template

From each of the 12 Fabrics, cut

2 x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " squares, cut in half diagonally twice.

You will have 96 triangles all together.

From the sashing fabric, cut

5 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

From each of the 6 fabrics cut 5 strips, but from one of the fabrics cut an extra strip. This will make 31 strips all together.

Making the Quilt

This is a very easy quilt to make. It's made up of 12 blocks.

Randomly mix your fabric, and lay it out as shown in diagram 1.

Assemble the blocks, start by sewing the white triangle to the patterned triangle next to it, to form a larger triangle, press back and repeat this 3 more times. Now take your white fabric from the template, and join it to the patterned triangle next to it, to form a larger triangle, repeat this 3 more times, you should now have 8 triangles. Continue to make up the block by joining the triangles together to form squares. Now join your 4 squares together, first in rows and then in columns to complete the block.

Repeat this process 11 more times.

Now lay out all of your blocks and sashing, ready to join together. At this point, you may want to move your blocks around until you end up with a pleasing arrangement.

Start by sewing the blocks and sashing together in rows, each row will have 4 strips of sashing, and 3 blocks.

Now make up your rows of the sashing. Start by taking one of your small squares, and joining to a strip of patterned fabric, repeat this until your strips of sashing are complete.

You are now ready to join all of your rows together.

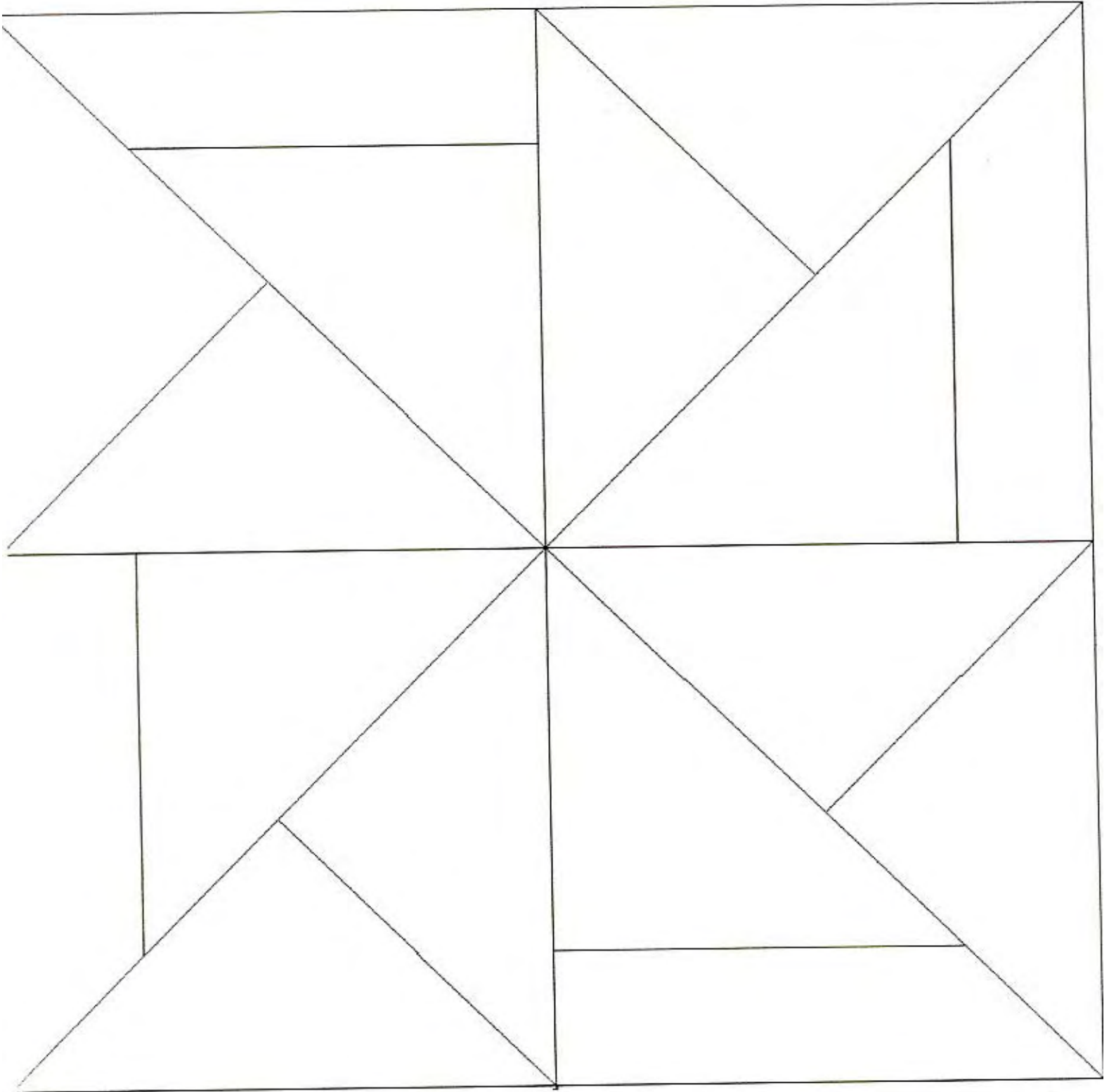
You will now need to add the border, starting with the top and bottom. Trim and press back. Now add the left and right sides, you will need to join two pieces of fabric to make a longer strip. Press back and trim.

The top layer is now complete.

Sandwich together the wadding and the backing.

Quilt by hand or machine, using floral designs.

When complete add Binding, using up scraps of left over fabric.

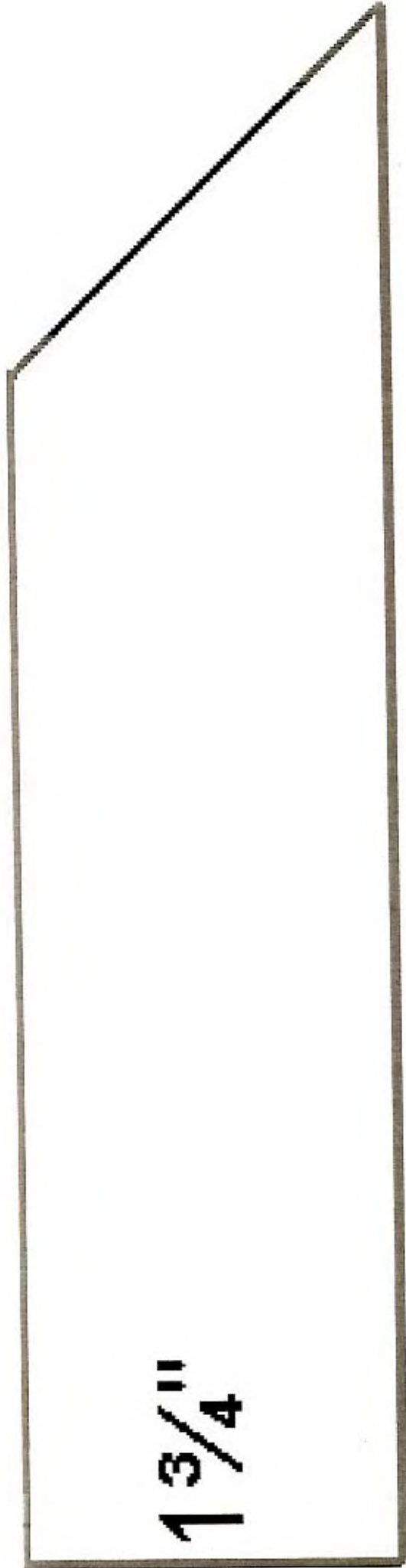
